Evaluation Methods Used: Testing CoursePoint involved a combination of manual and functional testing on desktop and mobile platforms. Level Access (Level) comprehensively tested a selection of pages representative of CoursePoint using, among other methodology, the screen reader JAWS 2019, exclusive use of the keyboard, and manual inspection of code. Level also functionally tested a set of five typical user flows with the JAWS 2019 screen reader, ZoomText screen magnifier and Dragon[®] NaturallySpeaking 15 speech recognition software.
